

## General Market Guidelines



1. Please arrive at least 1 hour prior and be set up and ready to sell 30min prior to the start of the market time. If your vehicle doesn't arrive 30min. prior to market time you will not be able to participate that day. Fees will NOT be carried over if you miss the market.
2. Vehicles MUST be removed prior to start of markets. Vendors aren't permitted to park in front of their space. Please be courteous of where you park.
3. All vendors who hold health permits must have a copy with them on site. (Inspections done regularly)
4. Standard stall rental is for a 10x10 space with a white canopy. Canopies are required due to sun/heat & rain except for Downtown Summerlin. Bring some type of weights, bottles, or buckets of sand/water to weigh down. Each canopy MUST BE secured for wind. We also suggest bringing plastic covering for merchandise in case of rain. Some type of lighting is required when it gets dark. Battery operated or electrical lighting can be used.
5. Please take into consideration that each vendor is part of a display. Make sure to keep tablecloths and booth clean. Professional conduct and appearance are always expected at Las Vegas Farmers Markets®. Any disruptive behavior by booth operators and/or their employees will not be tolerated. You will be asked to leave and not be able to sell again until permission is granted by market managers. Smoking is prohibited in booths by all vendors. (per Health Department)
6. All sales are to be conducted within your individual booth space. Any scales used in the market must have a current valid inspection seal from Weights and Measures. The spirit of commerce and fair pricing is recommended.
7. Dissemination of fliers, posters, signage, etc. is prohibited without prior approval of managers and must be in writing.
8. Each vendor is responsible for their own trash. All trash must be removed after each market. Bring a broom if necessary. We suggest bringing trash bags and containers. Please do not dump waste water on ground or in planters. Some markets have disposal sites, otherwise take it with you.
9. Tear down may commence at the end of the market and no earlier. Market committee may adjust hours, as they deem necessary due to weather or other conditions. When one vendor leaves early it affects us all. We are a team!
